Dear Year 2 Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to both a busy and exciting half term.

Our topic is Dungeons and Dragons. We explore the history of British castles and then begin to re-tell and create stories about the Dragons that might have lived there.

We will be visiting Arundel Castle on Wednesday 25th April and will finish the half term with a Medieval Banquet on Thursday 24th May. On the day of the banquet your child may come dressed for the party – Kings, Queens, Princes, Princesses, Knights, and Dragons all welcome.

If your child is unwell, we will ensure there are other opportunities for them to be assessed.

You can best support your child by: ensuring they have a good night's sleep; encouraging your child to both read and discuss a range of books with you; by positively supporting any homework that is set.

With SATs in mind we will be standing down any morning parental volunteers until after the May half term holiday. If you are able to help in an afternoon instead, please see your class teacher.
